- × Halogen Lamps/Light Bulbs
- × Extension Cords/Splitters
- × Wireless Routers
- × Bed Risers
- × Electric Blanket
- × Space Heater
- × Window/Personal Air Conditioners
- × Paper Lanterns or Lamps
- × Weapons
- × Fireworks
- × Decorative Alcohol Containers
- × Appliances with an open flame, coil, or heating unit
- × Live Christmas Trees
- × Pets (Fish in 10 gallon tank, or smaller, are permitted)
- × No more than 2 power strips may be used in a room at a time

### TIP:

Be sure to contact your roommate(s) and/or suitemates to coordinate who will bring which item(s). *There is not enough space in the rooms for two or three of each of these things.*

Make sure to pack all your belongings in totes **and label them with your name and room number**. Loose items can easily be lost or misplaced during move in
